

Pupil Premium Spend 2014/15

Pupil premium is additional funding provided to the school by the government in order to raise attainment for pupils who meet the qualifying criteria. The school received a total of £6605 in pupil premium grants for 2014/15.

Expenditure was used to raise attainment in literacy and numeracy through running inference groups, booster sessions for maths and English, small maths and English groups and 1 to 1 tuition in the core subjects.

Summary of Impact

- Accelerated progress in English & Maths. Rates of progress are comparable and in many cases more rapid than those not in receipt of pupil premium and exceed national averages.
- On average an improvement of 6 points in reading comprehension following participation in a 6 week inference programme
- Improved engagement and attendance by at least 10% in comparison to excluding school
- Improved self regulation and social and emotional development resulting allowing for better learning and improved chance to succeed when moving on.
